Target Clubs: Affiliated Clubs that organize events

Target Persons: All the exhibitors in CCC's cat shows

Whereas: cat shows are more and more popular.

Whereas: show cages have high purchasing, storage and maintenance costs.

Whereas: the loaned show cages are intended to facilitate the inclusion of new exhibitors and their transition to the acquisition of their own show materials.

On November 27, the Chats Canada Cats Board of Directors adopted the following directive regarding the loan of CAC cages for cat shows.

Starting January 1st, 2020:

Cage loan for new exhibitors:

- 1 - The CCC in partnership with the event organizing clubs will lend show cages to new exhibitors for their first three (3) shows, of one day or more, whether consecutive or not;
- 2 – After three (3) shows, exhibitors are considered to be experienced exhibitors and are subject to the guidelines below.

Cage loan to experienced exhibitors:

- 1 – Experienced exhibitors must pay for the rental of the CCC cage. Fees of \$ 10 will be charged for exhibitors who do not have a cage;
- 2 – The costs for additional spaces are not included in the CCC cage rental price;
- 3 – Rental fees collected by clubs must be returned to the CCC to help with storage, repair and maintenance of the cages;
- 4 – These charges will ultimately also be used to purchase additional batches of cages.

Transitional measures

- 1 – A grace period is granted to experienced exhibitors who use CCC cages;
- 2 – Cage rental fees will start at the Saint-Eustache cat show, in June 2020.

The Board of Directors, by this decision, hopes that the CCC will still be able, in the coming years, to offer the cage loan to new exhibitors.
