Administrative Directive – 2020-03

Clubs targeted: None

Target population: Anyone who has registered a cat at Chats Canada Cats

Whereas the Chats Canada Cats must ensure that the information on the recordings is correct and truthful.

Whereas the Chats Canada Cats must prevent fraud.

Whereas a cat whose color is changed more than once loses all its titles (Policy and Procedures Manual, Chapter 9, article 22.16)

On July 14, 2020, the Board of Directors of Chats Canada Cats adopted the following directive concerning the change of color and/or pattern on registrations, thus specifying section 2.7 of the Policy and Procedures Manual - chapter 4 - Registrations.

Persons authorized to observe a necessary change of color:

- 1 - The cat's breeder;
- 2 - A judge licensed by the Chats Canada Cats having completed the form for this purpose;
- 3 - The registrar upon presentation of genetic tests;
- 4 - The registrar when the color entered is invalid according to the genetics present on the pedigrees;
- 5 - The registrar when it is necessary to convert the colour/pattern's names between a foreign register and that of Chats Canada Cats.

When a recording has been issued, only those authorized to observe a necessary change of color can have the colour(s) and the pattern(s) registered on the registration changed.

Procedure:

- 1 - To proceed with the modifications to the registration, the cat's owner must send the original certificate to the registrar with an explanatory note and / or the related documents, as well as the payment of the reissue costs;
- 2 - When the file is complete, to the satisfaction of the registrar, the new certificate will be issued which will be sent to the owner;
- 3 - Under no circumstances may the registrar issue a duplicate for a colour(s)/pattern(s) change.

The board of directors, by this decision, clarifies the registration rules.
