**Whereas** the Chats Canada Cats offers privileges to members and it is up to the Board of Directors to set the privileges granted to members.

**Whereas** the objective of the Chats Canada Cats is to gain the support of Canadian cat breeders.

**Whereas** membership as an associate member was created with the aim that people who are thinking of starting or starting breeding can follow training or that non-breeders can participate in sectors of the associative life of the organization.

**Whereas** the Chats Canada Cats offers a grace period for breeders to transition their cats' registrations to the CCC, in accordance with article III a) and b) of the code of ethics signed upon joining as a as a regular member.

**Whereas** the Chats Canada Cats must not offer privileges to people who breed other species thus allowing them to circumvent the Animal Pedigree Act.

On August 17, 2020, the Chats Canada Cats Board of Directors adopted the following directive regarding member privileges.

Starting January 1st, 2021:

Associate Members:

- 1 - All people who join the CCC as an associate member will be able to benefit from the services of the organization at privileged prices (courses, registrations, etc.);
- 2 - All people who join the CCC as an associate member will not be able to obtain products from the organization at special prices (microchips, etc.)

Regular Members:

- 1 - All persons who join the CCC as a regular member will be able to benefit from the services of the organization at privileged prices (courses, registrations, etc.);
- 2 - All people who join the CCC as a regular member will be able to enjoy the organization's products at special prices (microchips, etc.), only if they have a registered cattery name;
- 3 - Any regular member, who does not transfer these cats from litters to the CCC within a reasonable timeframe may be denied the privilege of obtaining products and services from the organization, but also denied, membership to the organization.

The board of directors, by this decision, wishes to put an end to certain aberrations observed in the use of the products and services of the organization.
