Object: NOTICE TO MEMBERS – ASSESSMENT OF BREED ACTIVITIES

The Breeds Committee has, among other things, the mandate to evaluate the activity of the breeds recognized at Chats Canada Cats in order to determine if the breeds should retain their status based on their activity and the interest of breeders in these breeds.

The Breeds Committee calls for members, the following breeds are under evaluation:

- Sokoke
- York Chocolate

The committee must assess the following criteria:

- 1. the vigor of the breed in the world;
- the possibility of obtaining new breeders;
 - a. of its place of origin, if the race is natural;
 - b. by crossbreeding and rules of reappropriation, if the race was made by man;
- safeguarding processes put in place by recognized associations;
- 4. If the breed will be produced in Canada within the next two (2) years;
- That steps are underway for the purchase of breeding stock and that these cats will be registered and presented to Chats Canada Cats competitions.
