

***How do I change my address in CCC records and for the microchip number?
Why is this important?***

There are two very important reasons why you should update your address information:

1. To ensure that the owner's information is linked to the cat in Canada's registry of pedigreed cats held by CCC.
2. To ensure that the owner's information is current in the *Pet Home Today* Canadian microchip database in order to facilitate your cat's safe return when lost.

How to change your address:

Free of charge: YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A NEW CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION WITH YOUR NEW ADDRESS.

1. Send your new information (address, telephone number and email) to:
infos@chatscanadacats.ca.
2. Remember to include your cat's registration number in your email.
3. You will receive an email confirmation.
4. Your information will be updated in Canada's registry of pedigreed cats held by CCC AND in the *Pet Home Today* microchip registry.

For a fee: YOU WILL RECEIVE A NEW CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION WITH YOUR NEW ADDRESS.

1. Mail the former Certificate of Registration with your new information (address, telephone number and email) to us.
2. Calculate fees (including taxes) for the issuance of a new certificate (as indicated on the BACK of the certificate).
3. Mail the certificate with a cheque at the address indicated on the BACK of the certificate.
4. You will receive your new Certificate of Registration promptly.
5. Your information will be updated in Canada's registry of pedigreed cats held by CCC AND in the *Pet Home Today* microchip registry.
