FOREIGN BURMESE



The Foreign Burmese is an import and is a cat of foreign type which of positive and individual to the breed. Any suggestion of either Siamese type or cobbiness of the British Shorthair must be regarded as a fault.

I – BODY/CONFORMATION (35)

(25) BODY – Medium in length and size, hard, muscular and heavier than appearance indicates. Chest should be strong and rounded, the back straight from the shoulders to the rump.

(5) <u>LEGS & FEET</u> - Slender and in proportion to the body; hind legs slightly longer than the front. Feet small and oval.

(5) TAIL — Medium in length, thick at the base and tapering slightly to a rounded tip.

II - HEAD (30)

(15) HEAD — Top of head slightly rounded with good breadth between the ears, having wide cheekbones and tapering to a short blunt wedge. Definite nose break. Jaw is wide at hinge and has a strong lower jaw and chin.

(5) EARS — Medium in size, set well apart on the head, broad at the base with slightly rounded tips. The outer line of the ears continues the shape of the upper part of the face. This may not be possible in mature males who have developed fullness of cheeks. In profile, ears have a slight forward tilt.

(10) EYES — Set wide apart, large and lustrous. The tip line shows a slight oriental slant toward the nose, the lower line is rounded. Alert and bright.

III – COAT/LENGTH (10)

Short, fine, close lying to the body, satin-like texture, almost without undercoat and very glossy.

IV - COLOUR (20)

(15) BODY COLOUR — In all colours, the underparts of the body will be slightly paler than the back. In kittens and adolescents, allowance should be made for faint tabby barring and an overall lighter colour than adults. There should be no barring or shading in adults. The points (face, ears and tail) may show a little contrast.

(5) EYE COLOUR — All shades of gold to amber, golden yellow preferred. Preference is given to depth of colour.

V – CONDITION & BALANCE (5)

Hard and muscular, with no evidence of obesity, paunchiness, weakness or apathy.
